FROM OUR EDITOR

Dear Stakeholders,

We have left behind another month in which we celebrated the 101st anniversary of our Republic with enthusiasm and continued our education and training period with valuable activities. I would like to start our e-bulletin, which we have prepared with your contributions, with YÖKAK standards that guide our work.

The Research and Development section consists of three main headings. These are; 'C.1. Management of Research Processes and Research Resources', 'C.2. Research Competence, Collaborations and Supports' and 'C.3. Research Performance'.

C.1. Management of Research Processes and Research Resources: The research activities of our institution are managed in accordance with the academic priorities determined within the framework of the strategic plan and local, regional and national development goals, in a way that can produce value and be transformed into social benefit. It creates appropriate physical infrastructure and financial resources for these activities and ensures their effective use.

C.1.1. Management of Research Processes: Research processes at our university are managed under the coordination of our Research Dean's Office, primarily the rectorate. One of the main headings of your strategic plan is related to Research and Development activities. The effectiveness and success of research processes are monitored by academic unit managers and the Dean of Research, and research performance constitutes an important pillar of the academic performance evaluation process. Improvements in research performance are also ensured by the motivation and efforts of academic unit managers and the Dean of Research.

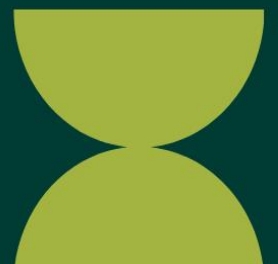
C.1.2. Internal and External Resources: The physical, technical and financial research resources of our university are planned in line with our mission, goals and strategies. The diversity and adequacy of the resources are monitored by the Research Dean's Office by taking stakeholder feedback. There is a Directive on Incentive for Academic Publications and Activities to encourage new researchers and all academicians to research. The Directive is reviewed and revised according to the needs by evaluating the changes in the internal resources of the University over the years, the effectiveness, adequacy, openness to development, and the level of meeting expectations. The rules regarding the use of internal resources are regulated by the Scientific Research Projects Directive. Trainings to improve researcher competence in accessing external resources are carried out under the coordination of the Dean of Research.

C.1.3. Doctoral Programmes and Postdoctoral Opportunities: Application processes for doctoral programmes, enrolled students, graduates and development trends are monitored and evaluated by the Graduate School Board of Directors. Postdoctoral opportunities are available in our institution and are regulated by the Directive on Visiting and Postdoctoral Researchers.

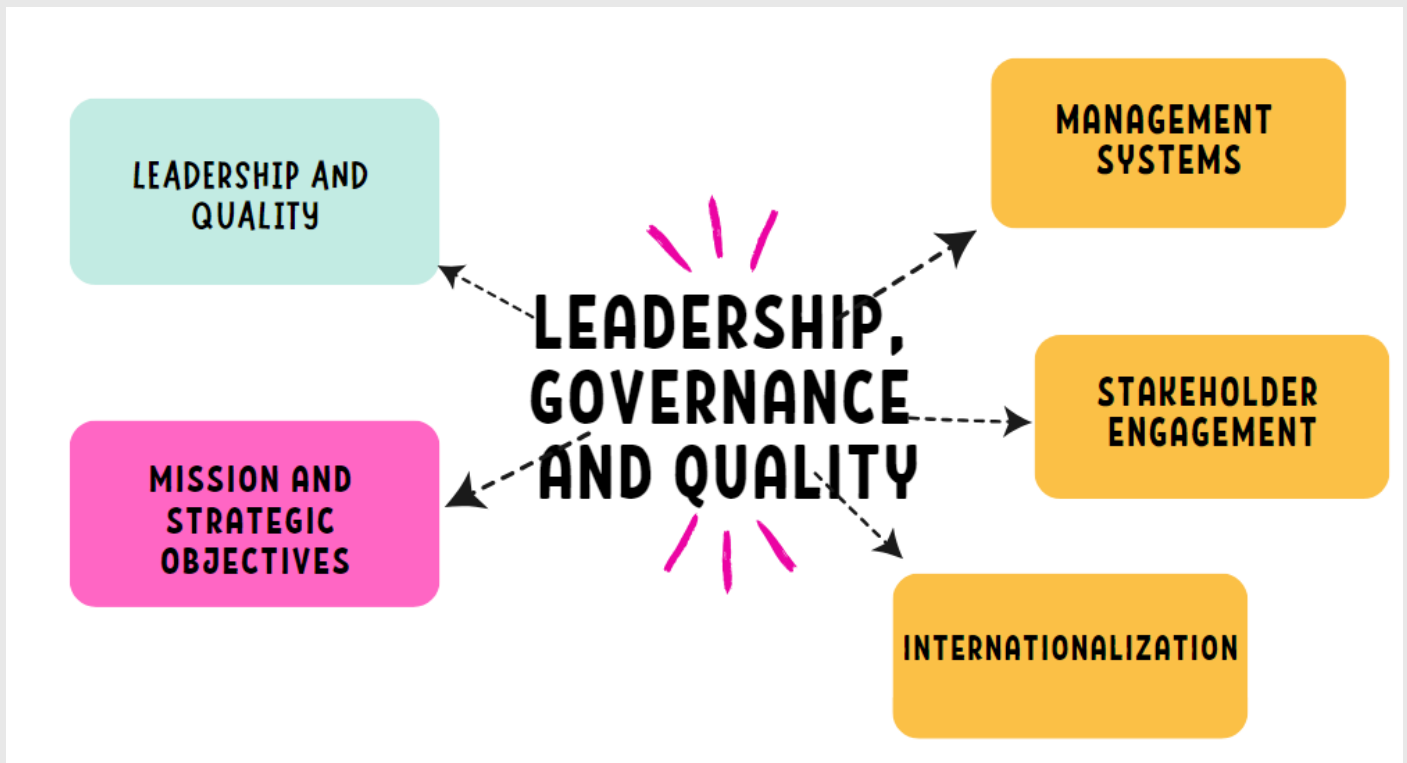

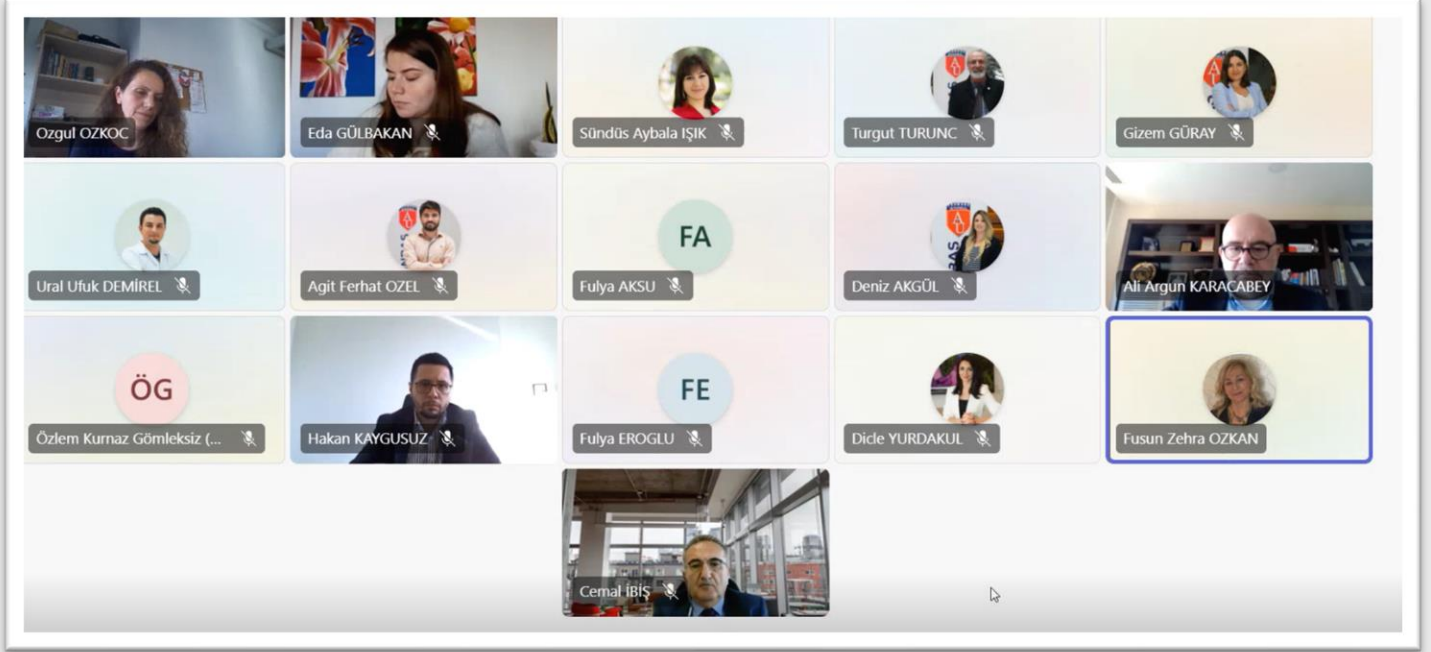

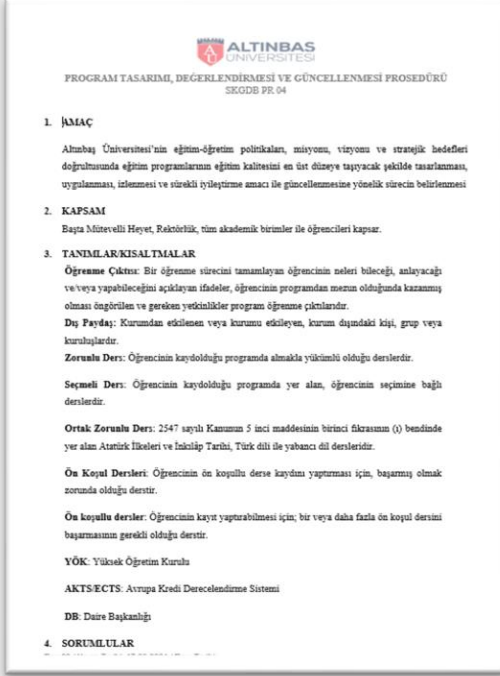

External stakeholder meeting, Student Satisfaction Survey Analysis results and self-assessment processes took place.

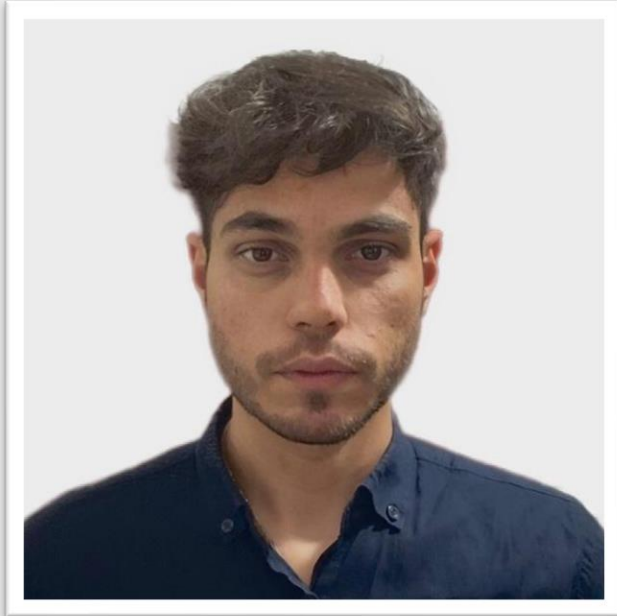
